Agreement

Made and entered into this day of A. D. 1926 by and

BETWEEN

of County, Michigan, first part, and THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a Corporation, second party.

Witnesseth, In consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, first part, for heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby grants unto said second party, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain, during the corporate existence of said second party its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, towers, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which own, or in which have an interest, in the County of and State of Michigan, the route of said line being as follows:

Date Sep. 28, 1926:

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE WASHTENAW LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during their corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to cut or trim any trees along said lines, which might fall or threaten to fall into the wires, upon, over, and across our property located in Township of Saline County of Washtenaw State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The West half of the Southwest quarter of Section three (3) Township four (4) South, Range five (5) East. The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, north of and adjacent to the South line of said land. The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein. In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of Twenty-five and 00/100 Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.

Second party shall have the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and shall have the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires clear at least Four (4) feet, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.

Second party agrees to reimburse said first part, heirs and assigns, for all damages to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
